Article 3 - statement of faith

The Trinity Children's Centre Association subscribes to the following basis of faith, to which all members, parents of learners, employees and office bearers must subscribe without reservation:

1. that the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are three persons of one Godhead;
2. the Triune God is the sovereign creator and sustainer of the entire universe;
3. that Holy Scripture is given by divine inspiration, is entirely trustworthy in its revelation of God and in His dealings with humankind, and is our supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct. It is without error in anything which it affirms;
4. that all people have sinned, stand guilty before God, and are subject to His judgment and condemnation;
5. that the Lord Jesus Christ, the incarnate Son of God, the only mediator between man and God, has, by dying for and on behalf of sinful humanity, effected the complete redemption of the sinner from every aspect of sin. This redemption affects all creation in the light of Romans 8:19-22; Ephesians 1:10 and other Biblical passages;
